Board and Parish Planning Meetings

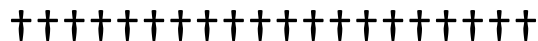

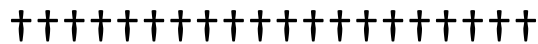
No School/Offices Closed
