On January 22, 1973 the Supreme Court of the United States, ruled that a woman had the right to abort the baby in her womb. Because we hold all life created by God as sacred, we are responding in January with a project to honor those women, despite the difficulties that they face, who are choosing life for their unborn children. There are several opportunities for each of us to be involved:

Donate items or money for baby shower gifts. These shower gifts will be given to the moms at Mountain Home. Items suggested are swaddles, newborn diapers, wipes, bottles, pacifiers, burp cloths, onesies, socks, gender neutral outfits, diaper rash cream, baby body wash, lotions, baby monitor.

Donate items for a gift for the mother. Items suggested are candle, face mask, nail polish, bubble bath or bath salts.

Donate toward the layettes we send to the mission field. The most needed items are long or short sleeved gowns, soap (Dove or Ivory), hand towels, and socks or if money is given to Laura Johnson she will shop for you.

Volunteer to be a member of an Open Table team offering support and friendship to women clients of Mountain Home.
