

"Gracious God, You Send Great Blessings" (LSB 782)
(main text by Eric A. Wismar)

In early 2004, as the final selections for LSB were being made, the Missouri Synod's Commission on Worship noted in one of its meetings that no entirely new texts had been included in the "Stewardship" section of the hymnal. Gregory Wismar, the vice-chair of the Commission, agreed to write a new text that would reflect stewardship of creation as well as the traditional themes of time and treasure. Reflecting on the assignment, Wismar recalls: "It had become my custom to work on writing assignments such as hymn texts and essays on worship while on the numerous airline flights between my home in Connecticut and St. Louis. This text was completed on a flight from Lambert Airport in St. Louis to Bradley Airport at Hartford on an evening flight after a Commission on Worship meeting. For me, a quiet airline flight was a most productive setting."
