

Hymn Corner

"Christ is Our Cornerstone" (LSB 912)
(main text by Robert A. Sorensen)
Director of Music, Chris Schelp

This hymn is taken from a longer Latin composition entitled "Urbs beata Hierusalem" ("Jerusalem, blessed city"), which dates to about the eighth century. Our oldest sources for this anonymous text are a handful of tenth- and eleventh-century manuscripts preserved in Britain, Spain, and France. "Christ is Our Cornerstone" is not based upon the whole original Latin text, but only its second half; already in the Middle Ages, these stanzas had been separated from the full text and sung as a hymn by themselves. There is another English translation of these same stanzas that is widely known: "Christ is Made the Sure Foundation" (LSB 909). Unless one knows that both derive from a common source, however, it is not at all obvious that they are from the same original. "Christ is Made the Sure Foundation" retains the meter of the Latin poem; "Christ is Our Cornerstone" does not.
