CARING CONVERSATIONS

Discuss in your home, small group, or use for personal reflections:

- Have you personally used *Taking Faith Home* this past year? If so, how?
- In what ways have you encouraged others in the congregation and community to use *Taking Faith Home*?
- Have you heard a story this past year about someone using *Taking Faith Home*? With whom and how did they use it? How was it a blessing for them and others?

DEVOTIONS

Read: Deuteronomy 6:4-9.

We are not born with faith embedded in our DNA structure. Teaching the faith and passing on the faith to the next generation does not happen through the work of congregations alone. It never has; it never will. In Deuteronomy one sees the power of cross-generational conversation and rituals and traditions that help children and adults be nourished in God's word for a life of faith. People need to be immersed into a faith-filled environment in the home to become fluent in a faith language. It does not happen in one hour a week. Who has helped you grow in the Christian faith? How can you walk with others and support them in living God's word?

Pray: **Loving God, thank you for your word of life that gives us hope and joy and is a source of encouragement to us as we grow in grace through Christ our Lord. Amen.**

RITUALS AND TRADITIONS

Taking Faith Home bulletin inserts are based on the Revised Common Lectionary. There is an insert for each Sunday, special days, and some holidays. They also include the weekly theme, daily Bible readings, a scripture verse, a weekly prayer, a mealtime prayer, a blessing to give, a hymn, and a time to talk about mountain highs and valley lows.
