

Super Summer 2020-2021 Application

Super Summer is a discipleship/evangelism leadership conference designed to provide spiritual growth and help develop student leadership in Mississippi churches. Utilizing a camp setting, for 30+ years, Super Summer has challenged students to learn how to penetrate their culture for Christ.

Super Summer is not for every student.

It is designed for students who personally have a desire to grow spiritually. Students come to Super Summer knowing that they will be challenged not only to grow, but to actively share their faith with others.

If you are interested in challenging yourself on this journey, **please read & pray over the requirements with your parents.** Once you have prayed, counted the cost of effort and time, and felt the Holy Spirit leading you to participate, please fill out the following application and return it to Allen **by Wednesday September 9th, 2020!**

SUPER SUMMER REQUIREMENTS

Remember this is not just a checklist of requirements, it should be set of lifestyle goals to live by as you follow Jesus.

1. Student must have completed the 8th grade but not yet in college.
2. Student agrees to attend all Super Summer sessions and participate in all activities.
3. Student must be a faithful, baptized believer and a member of a Southern Baptist Church.
4. Student must demonstrate qualities of leadership and of a growing Christian.
Qualities include humble, caring, considerate, servant's heart, loving, generous, friendly, looks out for others, self-controlled, integrity, truthful, helpful, respectable, submits to authority, avoids hypocrisy and controls one's speech.
5. Student must actively share testimonies of faith in their daily life.
6. Student must be devoted to prayer.
Commitment to a regular prayer time should consist of a daily prayer time as well as special times of prayer throughout the day as the need for prayer arises.
7. Student must be committed to a life of purity and abstinence.
This refers to pursuing sexual, emotional, spiritual & mental purity. Your goal should be to abstain from alcohol, illegal drugs, sexual sins, pornography, inappropriate music, video games, movies or tv shows.
8. Student must attend at least 75% of weekly church and student ministry events.
This includes Sunday School, Sunday A.M./P.M. & Wednesday Nights. If for some reason you will miss (Sports, work, etc.) you must let Allen know beforehand.
9. Student must participate in student ministry events that are designed as spiritual growth opportunities.
This includes Disciple Now, retreats, camps, etc.
10. Student must share a personal testimony with youth group before coming to Super Summer each year.
All students will be asked to share their testimony within their schools and family groups while at Super Summer.
11. Student must be involved in a "small group" discipleship study.
*Small groups will meet once a week during the requirement period and an attendance of 80% will be required to meet this requirement. Small groups will also be used as a goal tracker for other requirements such as Memory verses and Journal entries.***

12. Student will be required to memorize at least 10 scripture verses.
The list of possible memory verses will be given out after the application has been submitted.
13. Students will be required to participate in a S.O.A.P. journal of the book of Proverbs.
Materials and instructions will be given out after the application has been submitted.
14. Student must seek to spread the gospel in the local community
This includes being involved in church outreach, campus ministry, missions, and community service opportunities.
15. Students who will be attending their second year and above will be required to write an essay (100 words) which expresses your level of commitment to Christ and how you are involved in leadership in your church and community.
*This will be turned in to Allen before the end of the requirement period**.*
16. Student must submit 2 references from a teacher or employer.
*Reference forms will be given out once the application has been submitted and will be submitted before the end of the requirement period. ** Please provide your references with an envelope so it can be sealed when they return it to you.*
17. Student must be willing to serve as asked and live a life that is without question of your devotion to Christ!
There are many other areas to a life that follows Christ that are far too detailed to mention here, but if you live your life that is above any reproach or call any question to your faith, you will be living a life that is worthy of attending Super Summer.
18. Student must attend a one-on-one time of discussion with Allen once all requirements have been met.
This will be a time of reflection for the student to share their thoughts about the requirements that they have just completed and to share their desires for attending Super Summer.

****The Requirement Period will take place between Wednesday September 9, 2020, and Wednesday February 24, 2021. All requirements should be completed during this time. Failure to complete any requirement by the due date will result in a disqualification from attending Super Summer 2021.**
