3-Year Old Classes

(3 years old by September 1st)

A.M. Class—(Purple)

P.M. Class—(Yellow)

Tues, Thur—11:45 a.m. to 2:15 p.m.

A typical school day includes Bible stories, music in singing and movement, circle time for alphabet, numbers, colors and shapes, teacher guided activities and projects, snack time, story time, large motor skills play. We also include weekly chapel.
