- ❖ What types of abilities and talents have you been given? And how might you be able to use those to serve the Church?

❖ Why do you consider it important to be joined to a Church – the community of believers?

❖ What are some ways you can give witness to your identity as a Child of God so that others might see the love of Jesus in you?
