**LUTHERAN HOUR MINISTRIES** has a table at the Iowa State Fair and distributes Bibles and tracts every year. Iowa District East (IDE) and Iowa District West (IDW) share the expense of the table. This year the fair runs from August 10 through August 20. IDE takes the first day of the fair and then every other day except the last day. IDW takes the other days and the last day.
