Take a moment to notice the * at the beginning of various portions of the order of service. The * indicates the place where it is inappropriate to enter or leave the sanctuary because it marks a time of prayer or respect for the Word of the Lord. Please be considerate of others around you by honoring these notations.

The fourth Advent candle is PREPARE: A voice cries out: "In the wilderness PREPARE the way of the LORD." – Is. 40:3 "Prepare!" a voice echoes. Prepare what? A room? A meal? A plate of Christmas cookies? No. Prepare a HIGHWAY. God, it appears is on the move!

Advent means "coming." Christ came in the flesh at Bethlehem, He comes now in word and sacrament, and He will come again in judgment. As we look forward to His final coming, we find our deepest joy and comfort in His present coming with His very body and blood for our forgiveness. As we receive the Lord's Supper today, guests desiring communion are asked to speak with the pastor or elder before the service. For Scriptural reasons, we practice close communion.

AS WE GATHER The coming of God in all His unveiled power at Mount Sinai was terrifying to the people of Israel. The thundering voice of the Lord puts sinners in fear of death (Deut. 18:15-19).
