Good Shepherd established an Endowment Fund in 1991. Its mission is to ***“promote responsible Christian Stewardship of people’s accumulated assets and to enhance and expand the mission outreach objectives of Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd.”*** Each year the Governing Board distributes financial grants to further our ability to do God’s work with our hands locally and around the world. Because the Endowment Fund supports projects specifically outside of the congregation’s annual budget, these grants help to innovate and bring new ideas to how we serve our community and world.

- Ministries supported by the ELCA in our conference
- National and global mission needs of the ELCA
- Special programs and facility needs within our church at Good Shepherd
- Aid to individuals in time of special need

GRANTS AVAILABLE

As our Endowment Fund grows, we hope the dollars we can distribute will also increase. This year, multiple grants of \$500-\$1500 will be awarded. Grantees will be notified in May. A Celebration Luncheon is held in mid-June. Prior year recipients of grants include the Good Shepherd Clothes Closet, Northern Nevada International Center, Reconciling Works, Holy Yoga, college scholarships and many more.
