Strategic Work

We have much to celebrate and be thankful for. The work of the Call Committee has come to an end, and we will now have a new settled pastor who will begin serving with us September 21st. Our new pastor is Pastor Deborah Lyanga.

Pastor Deborah was born and raised in Tanzania, East Africa. She was ordained into the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Tanzania in 2005. She served as a congregational pastor for three years before being called to serve as the Director of Women's Ministries at the Central Diocese in Singida, Tanzania.

Pastor Deborah is married to Rev. Dr. Emmanuel Kaghondi and together they have two sons; Mercy, who will be a senior at Owatonna High School this fall and Abner, who will be in the 4th grade this fall. They moved to the US eight years ago and they both have their "green cards", which means they are permanent legal residents of the United States.

Pastor Deborah is leading a group of 14 people from her current congregation to Tanzania during August. They will be together in Tanzania for 2 weeks and then return home. Pastor Deborah will stay on in Tanzania for an additional 2 weeks to spend time with her family.

The Call Committee enjoyed meeting with Pastor Deborah. Her personality and kindness impressed us each time we interviewed her. I can honestly tell you that each member of the committee was "thumbs up" for her! We have found a gem. I <u>strongly encourage</u> each of you to spend a little time one on one with her.
