#### Psalm 122 Let Us Go to the House of the Lord

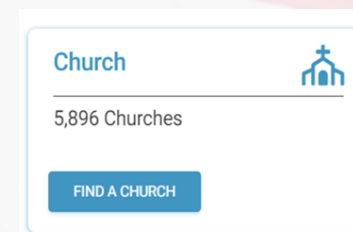
I was glad when they said to me,

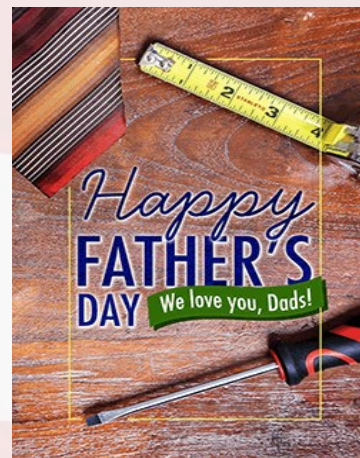


