 - Boone, Iowa, as well as Chicago and Minneapolis
- 875 churches, around 180,000 members

- 9 others in greater Kansas City area

- Commanded by Christ
- With a visible element
 - Baptism
 - Lord's Supper
 - Absolution

- Spirit is involved in a mysterious way
- Baptism
- Lord's Supper
- Immediate Grace, not means of grace

LCMS

- Points you to the means of Trust in one's conversion grace:
 - Baptism
 - Lord's Supper
 - Absolution
- Not based on you or your works, but on God and what He has done for you.

- Church as the Body of Christ

- Visible and invisible church Priesthood of All Believers
- Marks of the Church Preaching and the sacraments
- One divinely instituted office – the Preaching Office or the Office of the Keys
- Auxiliary offices are rooted in the Office

- Congregational Polity local authority, with pastors ordained nationally and hired locally (business-like model)
 - Everyone a minister
 - Reformed, catholic, Evangelical, and Apostolic

Miscellaneous

- Nationally, lots of focus on global mission and youth camps
- Like to use the phrase "loving believers"
- Six key teachings:
 - Bible is central
 - Necessity of New Birth
 - Conscious dependence on Spirit (some even speak in tongues, but only at home)
 - Whole mission of the church (social justice and evangelism)
 - Church is a fellowship of believers
 - Freedom in Christ (not to divide, but freedom to interpret)

Miscellaneous

- Major focus on relationships:
 - A human covenant between people and churches
 - Focus on Psalm 119:63 "I am a friend to all who fear you, to all who follow your precepts."
 - Freedom to interpret Scriptures differently
 - May come across as "wishy washy" but seen as being loving and accepting within the bounds of Scripture
