#### From Our Pastor's Desk

#### What I've been reading:

- From the Bible – *Ezra*, *Nehemiah*, *Gospels*: Over our time away, I finished out the Old Testament. The Israelites returned home under the leadership of Ezra the teacher and Nehemiah the prayer-warrior. They rebuilt the walls and the Temple in Jerusalem and enjoyed the restoration God promised. But we know from history that the Jews

didn't stay under their own power for long. The empire of Greece expanded their influence under Alexander the Great. Then, the Roman empire swept through under Caesar after Caesar. This sets the stage for the time of Jesus. It's exciting to read from all the Gospels at once, seeing how piece by piece fits in, how each author highlighted different events or offered a unique perspective, all while proclaiming the long-awaited Messiah, the Savior, the son of God (as I heard from the genealogy of Jesus just this morning.) After following the people of God looking forward to salvation, it's personally comforting to know that Jesus cares for all the people of God who look back, who have seen the salvation brought through Jesus, and who look forward to the day of his return.

- For fun: Over vacation, I had plenty of time for "fun" reading (my definition of fun might be different than yours.) I finished out the series of *When Cancer Comes* – look for those in our church library soon! I read a few leadership books that Heidi lent to me. *Me to We* taught me that church work can be more exciting and flourish when the pastor doesn't do it all. There are so many gifts to tap into in the body of Christ! In a similar vein, I also read *Doing Church as a Team.* Husbands, I read a short book called *30 Ways a Husband Can Bless His Wife*; there are some fun ideas for reminding your bride that you love her and God loves her. For a little more "fun," Cait and I listened to a few books during our drives. *Magic Hour* was about a little girl rescued from the woods who moved from selective mutism to learning and flourishing under the care of two sisters. We're working our way through *The Reformatory*, a historical novel that takes place in Florida and explores the struggles of racial conflict and injustice while a 12-year-old is locked up in a reformatory boys' school.

#### Refreshed and Restored:

- I love these kinds of "re-" words in the Bible. When we are worn down, broken, weary, God makes us new. Out with the old, because the light has come. It was good for Cait and me to have this time to reconnect and recuperate, and we're excited for this new stage of life – neither of us are students for the first time in our 10+ years together! We're so grateful that we get to "begin" adulthood with our family here at Grace! God's blessings for all the "new" he brings to all of us every day in this next month!
