Jesus' Lambs of Grace Early Childhood Board (ECB) Member

Mission Statement: Jesus' Lambs of Grace exists to assist parents in training their child socially, emotionally, physically, academically and spiritually in a loving, Christ-centered environment.

Description: The Early Childhood Board helps develop and carry out strategies to execute the Jesus' Lambs of Grace Preschool plan while actively supporting its mission and staff.

Qualifications:

- Adult member of Grace Lutheran Church or a parent of a child attending Jesus' Lambs of Grace who belongs to another LES congregation.
- A heart for the early childhood families, children and staff of Jesus' Lambs of Grace.
- Respects confidentiality of all sensitive and private information about the organization.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Actively grow as a leader through regular worship and Bible study.
- 2. Actively support and promote the mission of the school.
- 3. Develop strategies to execute the Jesus' Lambs of Grace Preschool plan within the scope of the congregation's and school's mission. (Note: Board members are not envisioned to be the actual workers who do the ministry but those who organize and enable others.)
 - a. Determine priorities.
 - b. Develop action plans and ensure a timely completion.
 - c. Appoint as many work groups or action committees as necessary to carry out the work.
- 4. Monitor the well-being of the preschool ministry.
- 5. Maintain regular contact with leaders and teachers of the preschool.
- 6. Assure ongoing development and evaluation of the preschool.
- 7. Conduct annual ministry reviews with the Preschool Director and submit to the Education Elder.
- 8. Support the Preschool Director by hearing and addressing the needs of both the school and the director personally or directing those needs to the appropriate leader.
- 9. Attend and participate in all ECB monthly meetings x 10 months (no meetings in July or December).
- 10. Attend as many preschool programs as possible. (Trike-A-Thon, Christmas Program, Pastries with Parents, Mother Goose Review, & Graduation)
- 11. Serve as champion and role model in promotion of all fundraising efforts.
- 12. Keep full and accurate records of ECB meetings and policy changes (one of the ECB members will be designated secretary at the beginning of each school year).
- 13. Suggest possible nominees to serve on the board to ensure a diverse and engaged board.

Time Commitment:

- 1-2 hours per month for meetings (1 per month) and small assignments.
- 3-year term, with the option to continue to serve as many one-year terms as desired.

Relationships: An Early Childhood Board member works with other ECB members, the Preschool director, Education Elder, Pastor, and communicates with the Preschool staff from time to time.

Training: Training is provided by the outgoing ECB member or other current ECB members.
