- 6. Research mission opportunities for donating Sunday School offerings.
- 7. Assist in the promotion of our Sunday School program and the strengthening of our partnership between parents and Sunday School staff.

- 1-year commitment, September through May. At-will after that, for as long as you are willing and able to serve.
