Vacation Bible School Ministry Craft Leader

Mission Statement: Grace Lutheran Church's Vacation Bible School serves children in PreK-6th grades in the church and the community by offering a fun and nurturing way to learn about Jesus Christ, all to the glory of God.

Description: The craft leader plans and orders prepackaged craft kits (according to each year's theme) for children ages 3 through 12 and leads the craft rotations during the week of VBS for the older children.

Qualifications:

- Member of Grace Lutheran Church or another WELS church
- Desire to work with children
- Positive attitude
- Well-organized

Responsibilities:

- 1. Consult with VBS team members to see which Bible lessons will be taught. Plan crafts related to the Bible lesson for each day of the week of VBS.
- Find crafts, craft kits, and supplies needed for the crafts online (Oriental Trading Company and Amazon – Office Admin will provide you with Grace's account information for these companies).
 Send order to VBS Coordinator for review before submitting. Once approved, place order and charge to Grace.
- 3. Lead the craft rotations during the week of VBS. Explain, demonstrate, and help with craft. Other VBS team members and crew leaders will help assist the children with the craft.
- 4. Attend planning meetings as able.

Time Commitment:

- Time involved includes monthly, down to weekly, planning meetings which start in mid-to-late
 May and continue through the end of July/beginning of August, depending what week VBS is
 held, as well as time to plan and order crafts and supplies.
- During VBS week, the craft leader will spend 1-2 hours per day for each day of that week to teach and then prepare the next day's project.
- At-will commitment, for as long as you are willing and able to serve.

Relationships: The craft leader works and collaborates with other members of the VBS team, the coordinator of VBS, and the pastor.

Training: Training will be provided by the outgoing craft leader. Other VBS team members may assist in the training.
