- 4. Coordination of pot-luck meal. Monitor the signup sheet to determine what will all be brought by members.
- 5. **Day of Picnic**: Be to church at 9:00am to start. Set up kitchen, prepare and put out the food, including what members are dropping off. The serving and cleanup of the meal will be done by other volunteers.
- 6. Review and document improvement and suggestions to existing format based on member/visitor input.

Time Commitment:

- 1-2 meetings prior to picnic.
- Time for shopping and purchasing food.
- 2-3 hours expected the weekend of the event.
- Commitment for 1 Church Picnic. Future picnics are at-will if you are willing and able to serve.
