Jesus Cares Ministry Greeter

Mission Statement: Jesus Cares Ministries desires to enhance the lives of people physically, mentally, and spiritually through the demonstration of the Gospel so they may know that Jesus Cares. Our primary focus at Jesus Cares Ministries is to do what Jesus commanded us to do, and that is to "Preach the Gospel to every creature on earth". That is first and foremost, to instill the love and nature of Jesus and to supply and fulfill their spiritual needs. There is nothing quite like the joy expressed when individuals with special needs are included and come together to praise God and hear the Gospel in a fun and meaningful way.

Description: A greeter welcomes participants into the building, assisting where needed.

Qualifications:

- Member of Grace Lutheran Church or other WELS congregation
- Desire to work with individuals who have special needs
- Positive attitude
- Friendly, outgoing personality

Responsibilities:

1. Greet the Jesus Cares participants.
2. Assist participants into the building as needed.
3. Hand out nametags (located in JCM cabinet).
4. Assist participants in getting settled (ie: hang up coat, find a seat, etc).
5. Collect and organize nametags at the conclusion of the event.
6. Attend occasional planning meetings.

Time Commitment:

- 1-2 hours every couple of months for team meetings.
- 1 hour per month for JCM Bible Class.
- 9-month commitment (September through May). May serve longer if you are willing and able to serve.
- The Jesus Cares Coordinator will contact you at the end of May to see if you would like to continue to serve in this position for the following year.

Relationships: This person works and collaborates with other members of the Jesus Cares Ministry team, the coordinator of Jesus Cares Ministry, the pastor, and the members and visitors we serve in connection with this ministry.

Training: Training will be provided by another JCM greeter or the JCM Coordinator.
