Property Care Ministry Grass Cutter

Mission Statement: Members of the Property Care Ministry serve our Lord and all who visit Grace Lutheran church by maintaining an environment in which members and guests feel welcome and safe, all to glorify God.

Description: The grass cutters serve the congregation by mowing the church property in a manner befitting God's house.

Qualifications:

- Member of Grace Lutheran Church
- Ability to operate a zero-turn riding lawn mower
- Ability to operate a walk behind gas powered lawn mower
- Ability to operate a gas-powered trimmer
- Ability to operate a gas-powered blower
- Reliable in performing the tasks when scheduled

Responsibilities:

1. Mow and trim the lawn the weeks that you are scheduled (preferably do this closer to the weekend services).
2. Clean mowers when done by blowing them off.
3. Refill the riding mower with gas.
4. If the gas containers are near or completely empty, notify the property elder.
5. Contact another grass cutter to switch weekends with you or contact one of the subs on the list well in advance if you are unable to cut the grass on a week that you are scheduled for.
6. Notify the grass cutting scheduler and the church office of any switches in the schedule that are made.
7. If any problems arise or equipment is damaged, please let the property elder, Mike Remiker, know ASAP.

Time Commitment:

- Two to three hours when scheduled (usually 4 or 5 times from early or mid-May to late October)
- At-will commitment, for as long as you are willing and able to serve.

Relationships: The grass cutters work with the other grass cutters and the property elder.

Training: Training will be provided by the property elder or another member of the grass cutting team.
