Communion Care Team Setup

Mission Statement: The communion care team of Grace Lutheran Church serves members and guests by preparing the Lord's communion table for distribution of the Lord's Supper, with love for our Savior, Jesus Christ.

Description: The communion setup team prepares the bread and the wine and sets up all necessary supplies for the organized distribution of the Lord's supper on the first and third Sundays, and the following Mondays, of each month, along with any additional services necessary throughout the church year.

Qualifications:

- Member of Grace Lutheran Church.
- Transportation to church for setup.
- Ability to keep track of communion schedule for the church year.

Responsibilities:

1. Set up communion, following the instructions provided, prior to the first and third Sunday 9:00am worship services.
2. After the service on communion Sundays, reset communion up for the Monday service. This may be done either on Sunday or Monday sometime before worship.
3. There are also other services throughout the church seasons for which communion is served. Setup can be done either the day of or the day before each of these services.
4. Setup can be done either by one person, or on a rotating basis if more than one person is on the team.
5. Let the office know when supplies are getting low.

Time Commitment:

- Approximately 1 - 2 hours per month, split between the first and third weekends each month.
- This is an at-will commitment, for as long as you are willing and able to serve.

Relationships: This person works with other members of the communion care team, if applicable, as well as the office staff.

Training: Training will be provided by the outgoing communion care person, or other members of the team.
