Communion Care Team Takedown

Mission Statement: The communion care team of Grace Lutheran Church serves members and guests by preparing the Lord's communion table for distribution of the Lord's Supper, with love for our Savior, Jesus Christ.

Description: The communion takedown person/team cleans up and puts away all communion supplies after the worship services on the Mondays following the first and third Sundays of each month, along with any additional communion services throughout the church year.

Qualifications:

- Member of Grace Lutheran Church.
- Transportation to church for cleanup.
- Ability to keep track of communion schedule for the church year.

Responsibilities: Take down supplies and clean up after communion, following the instructions provided, after the Monday 6:30pm worship services following the first and third Sundays of each month. The responsibilities may be split between other members of the team if applicable.

Time Commitment:

- Approximately 1 - 2 hours per month, split between the first and third Mondays each month.
- This is an at-will commitment, for as long as you are willing and able to serve.

Relationships: The communion takedown team works with other members of the team, if applicable.

Training: Training will be provided by the outgoing communion care person, or other members of the team.
