Big Ideas

- ➡ Jesus calls Peter to be a "fisher of men."
- ➡ Jesus also wants us to follow Him and be fishers of men.

Dear Parents:

In *Forgiving Challenge Kids*, we will take the next six weeks to look at forgiveness from the perspective of Peter in the Bible. What were his mess-ups? What did he have to 'fess up to? What mess needed to be cleaned up? How did Peter rise up after? When Peter got forgiven, what step up did he take in his life?
