THE RESURRECTION OF OUR LORD

9 April 2022, 10:15 am

AS WE GATHER

Death is our common enemy. But God has chosen to do battle with our enemy and has given to all the same victory won by Jesus Christ. The veil of death cast over all is now removed in Christ Jesus. Death and all its terror and power has been answered by the resurrection of Jesus once for all. We participate in this victory in the banquet our Lord has prepared, first in the Holy Communion of His crucified and risen flesh and blood, and then in the marriage feast of the Lamb, which has no end. Though for now we wait by faith for Him to bring to consummation all things, we wait as a people saved by His blood and marked for everlasting life. So let us be glad and rejoice in His salvation!

PROCESSION OF THE LIGHT

[With the church minimally lit, the pastor stands at the entrance to the sanctuary along with the candle bearer holding the CHRIST CANDLE.]

Please stand and face the entrance to the sanctuary.

Rejoice, O Church of Christ clothed in the brightness this light; let all this house of God ring out with rejoicing, with the praises of all God's faithful people.

P May the light of Christ, rising in glory, dispel the darkness of our hearts and minds.

P By becoming one of us to die for us, our Lord Jesus Christ paid for all our sins. When the Father raised Him on this glorious day, He showed all creation that He received that payment and nothing, even death itself, can stand between us and His gracious, eternal promises and the free gift of life everlasting.

As your pastor, it is my privilege to remind you of this forgiving grace of Jesus. Therefore, as a called and ordained servant of our risen Lord and Savior, and by His authority, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the **T** Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Gentiles Hear the Good News

L Peter opened his mouth and said: “Truly I understand that God shows no partiality, but in every nation anyone who fears him and does what is right is acceptable to him. As for the word that he sent to Israel, preaching good news of peace through Jesus Christ (he is Lord of all), you yourselves know

what happened throughout all Judea, beginning from Galilee after the baptism that John proclaimed: how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him. And we are witnesses of all that he did both in the country of the Jews and in Jerusalem. 1 Timothy 2:1-4

P Rejoicing in the resurrection of our Lord and sharing in His peace, let us pray for all people in Christ Jesus and all people as they have need.

With great joy and thanksgiving, we praise You, our Father in heaven, for the glorious resurrection of Your Son, Jesus Christ, our Lord and Redeemer.

By His life, death, and resurrection, He has granted us everlasting life with You. He has opened the way for us to know You forever and to live with confidence that You hear us when we pray, for: He lives, He lives, who once was dead;

P There are many among us who are in need, O Lord. For the sick, suffering, hurting, and ailing, we ask for Your healing touch, [*especially . . .*]. Help them to know that:
He lives to comfort me when faint;

C He lives to hear my soul's complaint.

P When the troubles of life seem overwhelming, steady us with Your presence, gracious God. Be the rock on which Your Church is built and through whom we confidently share the Good News of Christ's resurrection with the world He died to save. When we waver, help us to remember:
He lives to calm my troubled heart;

C He lives all blessings to impart.

P Death was not the end for Jesus; neither is it the end for those who trust in You. Give peace, hope, and the certainty of the coming Day of resurrection to all those who mourn and grieve, [*especially . . .*]. We are confident that:
He lives my mansion to prepare;

C He lives to bring me safely there.

P What a blessing it is to be in Your house today, Lord God, as we celebrate the resurrection of our Savior! His triumph over sin, death,

and the devil is the reason we rejoice this day, and every day, knowing that: He lives, and while He lives, I'll sing;

C He lives, my Prophet, Priest, and King.

P He lives, all glory to His name! He lives, my Jesus, still the same;

C Oh, the sweet joy this sentence gives: I know that my Redeemer lives! Amen.

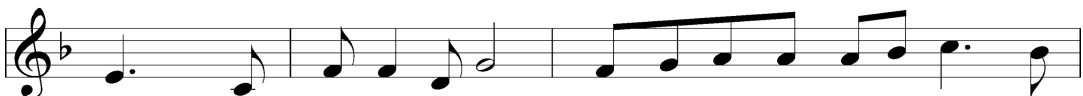
