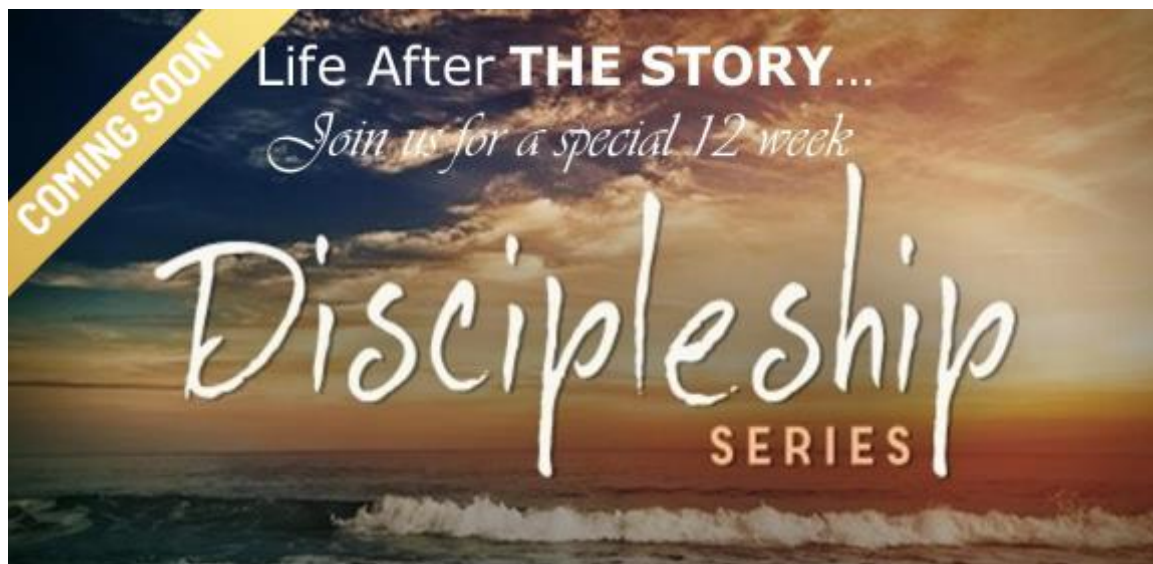

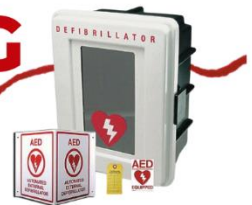

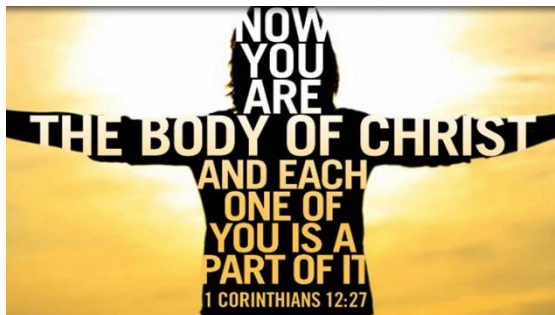
## Stewardship Challenge
