REPENTANCE AND RENEWAL

Almighty God in His mercy has given His one and only Son to die for you, and for His sake, forgives you all your sins. Therefore, as a called and ordained servant of Christ Jesus and by His authority, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit.

SACRAMENT OF THE LORD'S SUPPER

Holy Communion is a confession of the faith whereby we profess at this altar that our Lord Jesus Christ gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but His very body and blood to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with Him and with one another.
