At Christmas, kids cannot help but be filled with anticipation. Rather than dampen that anticipation, Advent Blocks is an attempt to channel it, building a practice that helps kids anticipate something much more exciting than presents—the birth of Jesus Christ, God in the flesh. Our hope for kids is that they would see how deeply God desires to be with them. That they would know God is with them, even when life is hard. That they would anticipate the beautiful and mystical reality that God has come to earth to stay.

Christmas is an astounding announcement that God has come to make the wrong things right and the dark things light. But it's also an announcement that's astoundingly easy to miss during all the holiday festivities. It is our hope that Advent Blocks will help families anticipate the greatest gift the world has ever known. The kits include stories and family activities that are easy to use. 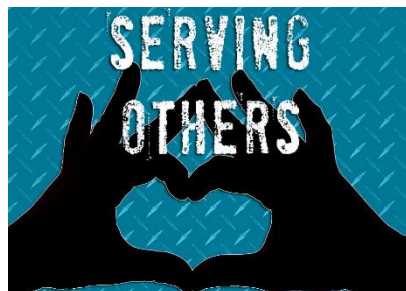
