AS WE GATHER

Epiphany is surely the season of the Christian apologist! Whereas at Christmastide we celebrate the fact that God truly became flesh, Epiphany is the time that we emphasize that the man Jesus truly is God. This revealing began with a star announcing God's birth. But it becomes even clearer—and even more dramatic—at Jesus' Baptism. The recorded history of Christ's Baptism is included among stories of turning water to wine, miraculous healing, casting out demons, and omniscience. These historical events performed before eyewitnesses (like Jesus' death and resurrection to follow) prove that Jesus is not just a person claiming to be God. They instead point to an utterly unique Messiah who stands alone as the Savior of the world. Epiphany is indeed our time to proclaim Jesus' credentials as we head toward Lent and the most important weekend in the history of the world.

We know that Christ being raised from the dead will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him. For the death he died he died to sin, once for all, but the life he lives he lives to God. So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus.


SERVICE OF THE SACRAMENT










PROPER PREFACE






