Lutherans in Africa

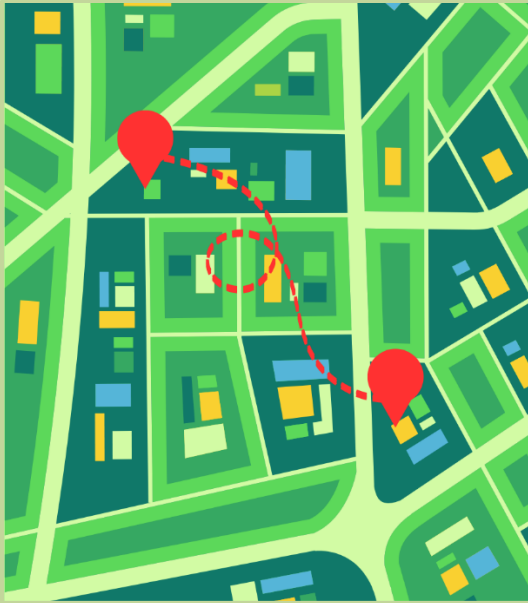
Mission Presentation

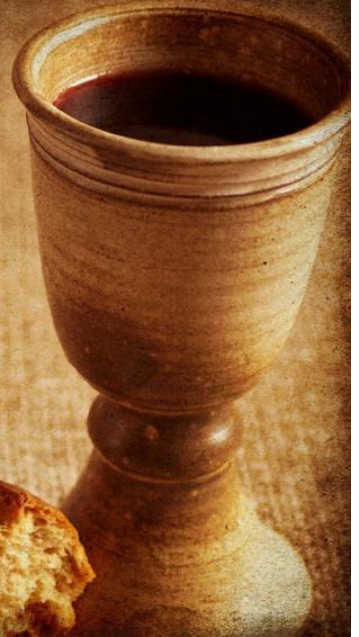

Lent & Holy Week Schedule



Ash Wednesday FEBRUARY 14, 6:00pm

Ash Wednesday is a solemn reminder of human mortality and the need for reconciliation with God and marks the beginning of the Lenten season. **Holy Communion.** Vespers @ 5:15pm & Soup Supper @ 6:00pm, February 21-March 20.



Palm Sunday MARCH 24, 10:15am

Sunday before Easter. It is a celebration of Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem, observed with palm branches



Maundy Thursday MARCH 28, 6:00pm

Thursday before Easter. It commemorates the Last Supper and foot washing, often observed with stripping of the altar. **Holy Communion**



Good Friday MARCH 29. 6:00pm

Friday before Easter. It is a most solemn day as we observe the day Jesus was crucified. **Holy Communion**



Holy Saturday MARCH 30, 6:00pm

Saturday before Easter. It observes the day Jesus was in the tomb. It is a day of somber reflection.



Resurrection Sunday MARCH 31, 10:15am

Hallelujah! Christ has risen! It is a day of joyful celebrations. This day we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus. **Holy Communion**
