AS WE GATHER

The theme of the First Sunday in Lent is always trial and temptation. The Old Testament Reading (Genesis 22) illustrates trial as Abraham is called to sacrifice Isaac. The Gospel from Mark tells in brief of Jesus' temptation. The reading from James refers to both trial and temptation. The emphasis is that temptation brings forth sin, and despite what we might think or want to think, God has no part in tempting us to sin. James 1:12–18, the Epistle, serves as a bridge between the lessons in the Old Testament and Gospel. James wants to convey a proper understanding of how trials and temptations fit within the Christian life and how God supplies what we need to deal with both.
