

The Leslie Ann Scholarship Program

Introduction

The *Leslie Ann Scholarship* program is administered by the *Leslie Ann Youth Memorial Fund*. In spirit of Leslie Ann's love for youth, the fund's mission is to promote positive Christian experiences that can leave an everlasting impact on the lives of children, teenagers and college youth. The Leslie Ann Scholarship is awarded to members of Greenford Lutheran Church, who are under the age of 24 and are active in a degree program. Current scholarship amounts are \$500.00 to full-time students (12 credits or more) and \$250.00 to part-time students.

Application Process

To be eligible, students must be active members of Greenford Lutheran Church for at least one year and attending college within one year of their high school graduation. Students remain eligible for the first four academic years after their graduation date. Other special circumstances will be considered by the committee. Students may reapply for the scholarship prior to their second, third and fourth year of study. Students entering a fifth year of study or beginning a post-graduate degree are no longer eligible.

The following items must be received by the committee on or before July 1st of each year.

- An application form
- Two reference letters mailed directly to the committee (no family members)
- An official copy of high school transcripts
- After the first year of study, students must resubmit a student application form and provide official transcripts from the previous year of college.
