GARDENERS IN THE GROVE: Join us Friday mornings at 9 am!

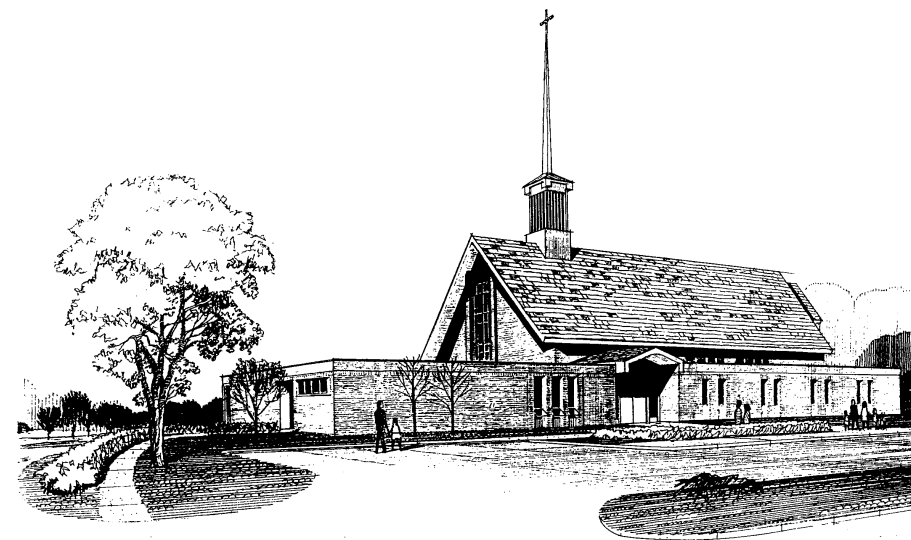
UPPER ROOMS: September/October Upper Rooms are in and can be picked up in the Narthex.
