

<u>United Women in Faith (UWF)</u> will meet at 10 am this Thursday for a time of learning and fellowship. All women of the church and community welcome.


## Holy Week at Grove United Methodist Church 1020 Tyler Ave., Radford, VA March 24 through March 31, 2024
