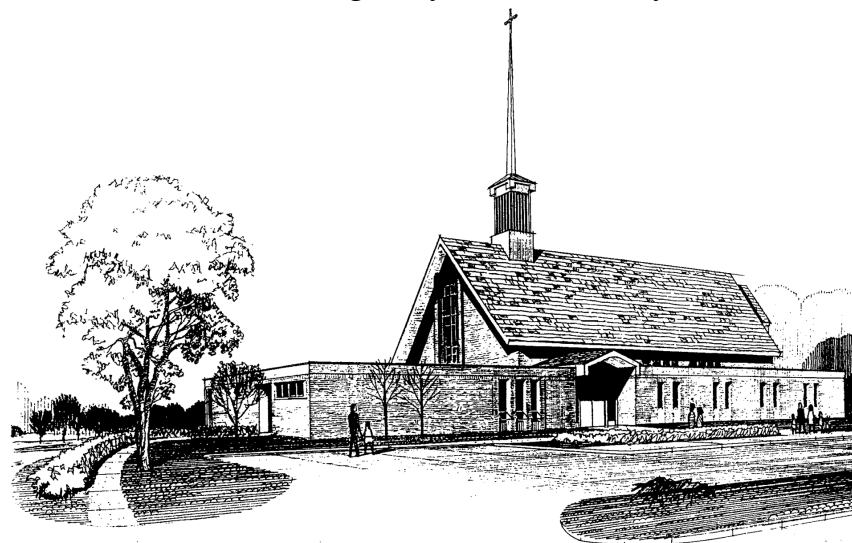

Maundy Thursday Worship with Communion and Tenebrae

What to expect: This service includes communion as we remember the last Supper Jesus shared with his disciples. Following communion we will share in the ancient Christian Tenebrae service. A service of readings and extinguishing of candles that gradually moves us from light to darkness as a symbol of our Savior's death. Nursery Provided.

Walking the Way of the Cross

What to expect: A movement worship experience beginning in the sanctuary and moving outdoors as we walk Grove grounds reading, reflecting and praying through six stations of the cross that commemorate the last hours of our Savior's journey to the cross. Provisions made for non-walkers and those who prefer to keep vigil in the sanctuary.

7:00 am Easter Sunrise

What to expect: Worship and celebrate our risen Lord on the backgrounds of Grove UMC as we watch the sunrise and hear the Easter story of that first morning at the tomb. Worship will be followed by breakfast in the Fellowship Hall.

10:00 am Easter Worship with Communion

What to expect: As you come to worship, bring your cut flowers to help decorate the Resurrection cross. Enjoy a cup of coffee and pastries prior to worship. At 10 am gather in the sanctuary as we sing and proclaim together the glory of our Risen Lord and Savior. Nursery provided.
