# God loves all people. During our Bible lesson, we will learn how God showed love to Adam and Eve when they sinned.

### Story Review Riddles

Color the story pictures and raise the picture that answers each riddle below. Hint some riddles need two pictures.

- 1. I made Adam and Eve perfect. I told Adam and Eve not to eat from the tree of knowing about good and evil. [God.]
- 2. God made us perfect. We were happy to live and work in the garden. [Adam and Eve.]
- 3. I talked to Eve. I asked her about the fruit. [The devil (snake).]
- 4. I hate God. I wanted Eve to sin. [The devil (snake).]
- 5. Eve looked at me. I looked delicious. [The fruit.]
- 6. Eve gave me some of the fruit, and I ate it. [Adam.]
- 7. We sinned. [Adam, Eve, and the devil.]
- 8. We tried to hide from God. [Adam and Eve.]
- 9. I still loved Adam and Eve. I promised to send Jesus to be the Savior. [God.]
- 10. Jesus would fight against me. He would win. [The devil (snake).]
- 11. He kept his promise and sent his Son to die on the cross to take away all sins. [God.]

### Action Poem

Jesus died on the cross for me.

(make a cross with your index fingers)

I love and obey him happily.

(press hands against heart; hold hands out)



## Paper Snake Craft

(Materials: strips of paper, paper head, googly eyes, red tonque, sticks)



#### Directions:

- 1. Link all the strips of paper together to make a chain.
- 2. Glue eyes and tongue on face of snake and body.
- 3. Glue 2 sticks together to form a cross

Today's craft reminds us how God sent us a Savior to save us from our sins and the devil.
