

You might say that a reason is an explanation for why you have chosen to do or not to do something. It is justification for your decision. On the other hand, an excuse is a way of getting out of something that you don't want to do. While I suppose that both could technically be used interchangeably, I think that you would probably agree that "reason" has more of positive connotation than "excuse." Are you good at coming up with excuses? I asked the 5-8 graders to give excuses for not doing things like cleaning their room and helping with yard work, and I don't think that they struggled with excuses. Unfortunately, I don't think that's something that we outgrow and it can easily carry over into our Christian lives. Today we hear God answer the **excuses** of Moses and see how God gives us plenty of **reasons** to follow him in faith.
