Week 9 - The Ten Commandments

This week's Bible lesson tells us about when God descended on Mount Sinai in fire and spoke the words of the Ten Commandments to the Israelites. Then God gave Moses many other laws for the Israelites to follow and the people promised to obey them.

In the first three commandments, God was telling the Israelites ways they could show love for Him. In the last seven commandments, God commands his people to show love for each other. Write (on the lines provided) or talk about one way that you can obey each commandment.

1.	You shall have no other gods.		
2.	You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God		
3.	Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.		
4. Honor your father and mother, that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth.			
5.	You shall not murder.		
6.	You shall not commit adultery.		
7.	You shall not steal.		
8.	You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.		
9.	You shall not covet your neighbor's house.		
	10. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, workers, animals or anything that belongs to your neighbor.
