in your Bible: Exodus 24:12-18; 32; 33:4-6; 34:1-10, 28-32 (Bible recommended for this story)

For this week's Bible story, I would suggest using a Bible or viewing the video bible study. You can find a link to it from the church website. Here's a quick overview of the story: While Moses was on Mount Sinai, the Israelites worshipped a golden calf as their god. God told Moses that he would destroy the Israelites. Moses then went down and punished the people for their sin. Then he returned to the Lord and prayed for the Israelites. Out of love God forgave the people.

Praying for Others

To follow Moses' example by praying for other people just as he prayed for the Israelites. God also wants us to pray for other people. Take some time and think of some people who you can pray for. Make a list of these people and pray for them often. You can pray on your own or with your family during family devotions.


Art Project: Embossed Plaques

Each child will make an "embossed" plaque as a reminder that God forgives their sins. This will be a 2 day project and may require some help from an adult.

Day 1:

Use a pencil to print "GOD FORGIVES" on the 8.5x 5.5 piece of card stock. Make sure your letters are large, neat and spaced out enough. If you have extra space, you can also draw a heart or cross.

Carefully trace over your letters (and drawings) with thick lines of glue. You could also use the glue to make a border of dots around the outside edge of your plaque. Allow the glue to dry overnight.



Day 2:

Lay your piece of foil over your plaque. Fold the edges around the plaque, and tape the foil in back. Then lightly rub the foil with a fingertip to bring out the letters and the designs. Press gently so that you do not tear the foil.

Glue your plaque on to your sheet of construction paper for a border. Feel free to decorate the border in any way you would like.
