Story Review and Application

- 1. Who did God chose to be the next leader of his people? [Joshua]
- 2. God promised to be with Joshua just like Moses. Who else does he promise to be with? [you and me]
- 3. What miracle did God perform to lead his people across the Jordan River? [He stopped the river flow and had the people cross on dry land]

God kept his promise to the Israelites and led them to the land of Canaan!

- 4. Why did the Israelites build a pile of 12 stones after crossing the river? [to remind them of God's promise]
- 5. Where does God promise to take us after this earthly life? [Heaven]

Memory Treasure: Revelation 2:10b "I will give you life as your victor's crown"

Craft

Make a paper crown to remind you of God's promise of Heaven (print and use attached pattern or make your own version)



Directions:

- 1. Color the strips of paper and a cross.
- Tape/staple the strips of paper together and fit around head.
- 3. Glue or tape the cross to the front of the crown.

Reminder of God's Promises

As a family, use 12 of one kind of object (books, pillows, toy blocks, play-doh balls) to make a memorial similar to the Israelites' stone pile. Each time a family member adds an object, recall a time or way God helped your family or kept one of His promises.
