1. What did the angels tell the shepherds? [Jesus, the Savior, had been born]

3. Read the memory treasure: John 3.16. Who loves us all most of all? [God]
4. How do you feel when you get a special gift? [Happy]
5. Who might you tell about a special gift you received? [friends; grandparents; neighbors]

*Just like the shepherds hurried to tell others, we can tell others about Jesus our Savior the gift for all the world.*
