[A trumpet and torch].
- 4. God promised to help Gideon and his small army win the fight against the Midianites. How did God keep his promise?**
[He made the Midianites so confused that they killed one another.]
- 5. God can also use his amazing power to help us when we have hard things to do. What is the most important way God helped all sinners?**
[He sent Jesus to take away our sins.]
