## **THE LORD'S PRAYER**

Sermon Series Begins June 6

The Lord's Prayer is probably one of the most well-known and often said prayers by people. Even people with little religious background recognize the Lord's Prayer. As familiar as the words may be to us, how often do we stop to consider what each of those phrases mean and how they apply to us? This summer we will do just that. Each week we will look at a different section of the Lord's Prayer, studying the thoughts that relate to it. Come, and rediscover the beautiful pictures and depth of content that is found in this prayer that normally takes less than 20 seconds for us to pray!

## **Masks in Worship**

Our Good Shepherd leadership has looked to the CDC and La Crosse County Health Department for guidance in how to safely operate during COVID and has made changes as they were recommended. The newest recommendations from the CDC [ *Fully vaccinated people no longer need to wear masks outdoors or in most indoor settings, according to newly updated guidance from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS)* ] which the La Crosse County Health Departments has routinely based its recommendations upon does do not require masks for people who have been full vaccinated. **Therefore,**

**beginning the weekend of May 30, we will no longer require those attending in-person worship to wear masks if fully vaccinated.** We also realize that there will be those who may feel more comfortable continuing to wearing masks even though fully vaccinated. Therefore, pastor will continue to wear a mask while distributing the Lord's Supper for the time being. Let's be sensitive of each other's personal decisions and treat one another with Christian love, trust, patience and understanding.
