We marvel, as well, that even now, in his fearful times and through the power of the Holy Spirit, Ross is still a faithful, powerful witness to his Lord and Savior.

Let us pray for La Von and Ross: "Almighty God, graciously comfort La Von in her suffering and be with her as she undergoes medical testing. Take away her fear, and strengthen her faith

that she may trust in Your merciful will and cling to Your salvation through Jesus Christ, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen."
