



No Avocado Green Appliances?!! By Mike Liebe

Our Kitchen Refresh Committee, led by Jan Walker, has been busy and we are ready to proceed with updating our Parish Hall kitchen. The committee created the scope, researched options for finishes and appliances, and compiled estimated expenses, keeping good stewardship in mind. They have presented their project plan to the Council, and we would like to share it with you. After many years of service by appliances and fixtures that have set near records beyond life expectancy (due to our responsible use and good care), we will have a newly updated kitchen when the project is completed. Ready for many more years of service and fellowship.



The scope of the refresh includes repair and refinishing of all counters, two new smooth-top ranges/ovens, two new refrigerators with operating ice makers, two new range hoods, two new faucets, fresh paint and refreshed cabinets, and a new free-standing cabinet for easier access of paper goods. The estimated cost for everything, including delivery and installation is \$12,900. We are adding a buffer of 10% for unexpected items and possible appliance price increases (inflation) for a total project working number of \$14,100. As mentioned in our last Voters Assembly Meeting, the Council discussed sources to fund the project. Our plan that we are proposing to you is to pay approximately one half from the Kitchen Club restricted fund at \$6,950 and the balance to come from our operating funds. Blessed by generous giving, we have available operating funds at this time.

The Council will confirm your support for the funding plan soon. You can contribute directly to the project through the collection plate on Sunday morning or by using our Holy Cross website, http://www.holycrossconcord.org, to get to our secure Vanco giving page.
