Baptism: God's Gracious Gift to Us Sinners





Covid exposure kept Joyce from the walk and Cherylene staffed the team table while the other five did the two mile walk around Golden Hills Community Church in Brentwood. The event was very well organized. Coffee, water, and a lite snack were set up



when the workers arrived. There was plentiful parking, and easy registration. Shirts were handed out, instructions and announcements followed. We prayed, and the walk began! The walkers returned and collected their free box lunch. Tables in the shade made for a restful time of fellowship as we enjoyed lunch. Closing announcements, awarding prizes, and prayer ended a successful event. The count is not final, but the numbers are good!

So far, the walk has raised \$55,000. Team Holy Cross raised \$750!

New refrigerators will be the next step including bringing a water line from the janitors closet for the ice makers on these appliances. The final process will include new range hoods, a new faucet, stainless steel microwave, and cleaning of the wood cabinets. Some touch up painting, refinishing of the wooden chopping block, and removing the old freezer will have our kitchen looking like something out of the FoodNetwork!!
