From the Pastor...

Still Experimenting

As we began this past Summer, we chose to experiment with our worship life together. That experiment has been one that has helped to breathe new life and vibrancy into our congregation. This past Sunday, as I was distributing communion, I was overwhelmed by the volume of the voices that were singing at that time. My heart was overflowing with joy, in the way we were together and celebrating God's gifts of grace at that moment in time. That moment is what some Christians call a "thin" place. It is a place and time when heaven and earth seem to be touching, and the divine is felt, seen, and heard in our midst. God is truly always there with us, however "thin" places are when that presence seems clearer. I am grateful, because it is by experimenting that we have discovered many of those "thin" places.

As we officially enter the season of fall, it is my hope that we will continue to experiment and discover new "thin" places of grace together. We have been experimenting with our **SUNDAY LIFT** gatherings on **Sunday mornings at 9am**. Sunday Lift is based on the four components by which the early church operated. Acts 2:42 says, "The believers devoted themselves to the apostles' **teaching**, to the **community**, to their **shared meals**, and to their **prayers**" (CEB). We are taking an ancient practice and experimenting with it in new ways through eating, learning, sharing, playing, and praying.

During our Sunday Lift experiment, I have gotten to watch people of different generations share their lives and create "thin" places in beautiful ways. I watched a kindergartener share with someone in their late 40's about how their grandfather had passed a while ago. I've heard old family stories shared with young people. I've seen complete strangers become friends as they worked together on one of the day's activities. We have laughed, sung, learned, and eaten;


