Love shall be our token; Love be yours and love be mine, Love to God and neighbor, Love for plea and gift and sign. Love came down at Christmas...Love came down.



All this for us our God has done Granting love through His own Son. Therefore, all Christendom, rejoice And sing His praise with endless voice. Alleluia!


#### Stand
