Prayer for the Seventh Sunday of Easter

O Triune God, may we be kept in the faith by hearing and studying Your Word where we learn the good news of our forgiveness in Christ and by receiving the Lord's Supper. Grant that our faith be thus strengthened so that the questions that lie heavy on our hearts and in the back of our minds no longer cause us anxious moments: How can we be sure that we won't fall away from our faith in Jesus? How can we be sure that our faith won't become so weak that we reject Your Son when the going "gets tough"? How can we be sure that our faith won't be swallowed up with the cares of this life? Thank You, O God, that Jesus prayed thus for us, "... I have prayed for you, that your faith should not fail." May Your Spirit keep us faithful until we are called home. Amen.



The Lord's Supper is celebrated at this congregation in the confession and glad confidence that, as He says, our Lord gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but His very body and blood to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with Him and with one another. Our Lord invites to His table those who trust in His words, repent of all sin, and set aside any refusal to forgive and love as He forgives and loves us, that they may show forth His death until He comes.

Because those who eat and drink our Lord's body and blood unworthily do so to their great harm (1 Cor. 11:17-34), and because Holy Communion is a confession of the faith which is confessed at this altar, any who are not yet instructed, or who hold a confession differing from that of this congregation and The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, and yet desire to receive the Sacrament, are asked to speak with the Pastor prior to communing with us for the first time. We thank you for respecting our belief and practice regarding the Lord's Supper.

First Reading: Acts 1:12–26

Then [the apostles] returned to Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is near Jerusalem, a Sabbath day's journey away. And when they had entered, they went up to the upper room, where they were staying, Peter and John and James and Andrew, Philip and Thomas, Bartholomew and Matthew, James the son of Alphaeus and Simon the Zealot and Judas the son of James. All these with one accord were devoting themselves to prayer, together with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and his brothers.

In those days Peter stood up among the brothers (the company of persons was in all about 120) and said, "Brothers, the Scripture had to be fulfilled, which the Holy Spirit spoke beforehand by the mouth of David concerning Judas, who became a guide to those who arrested Jesus. For he was numbered among us and was allotted his share in this ministry." (Now this man bought a field with the reward of his wickedness, and falling headlong he burst open in the middle and all his bowels gushed out. And it became known to all the inhabitants of Jerusalem, so that the field was called in their own language Akeldama, that is, Field of Blood.) "For it is written in the Book of Psalms,

"May his camp become desolate,
and let there be no one to dwell in it';

and

"Let another take his office.'

So one of the men who have accompanied us during all the time that the Lord Jesus went in and out among us, beginning from the baptism of John until the day when he was taken up from us—one of these men must become with us a witness to his resurrection." And they put forward two, Joseph called Barsabbas, who was also called Justus, and Matthias. And they prayed and said, "You, Lord, who know the hearts of all, show which one of these two you have chosen to take the place in this ministry and apostleship from which Judas turned aside to go to his own place." And they cast lots for them, and the lot fell on Matthias, and he was numbered with the eleven apostles.

Training Pastors to Pastor God's People



Since its founding in 1996, the Lutheran Theological Seminary in Novosibirsk, Siberia, has become recognized as a leading pastoral training school in Russia.

Keeping a great seminary operating can be just as challenging as building it. Besides normal operating expenses, the seminary also pays educational and living expenses while students pursue their studies. If the seminary closes, it is unlikely to reopen because of the financial burden

The 52nd Rocky Mountain District Convention will be held June 9-10. The Rocky Mountain District Board of Directors has selected the Siberian Lutheran Seminary in Novosibirsk, Russia to be this year's Convention offering recipient, and is asking each congregation to bring a special gift toward this offering.

Holy Cross will take up a special offering through June 5 that will be presented at the Convention and subsequently be given to the Lutheran Theological Seminary in Siberia. There is a basket at the back of the sanctuary to gather these offerings.

The District Board has been learning about the tremendous work being done through The Siberian Lutheran Seminary and is excited to propose to the Convention that our District congregations embrace this international mission throughout the next triennium. Through the Holy Spirit's power, this seminary and the pastors graduating from it, are once again evangelizing Russia, a place where God's light was nearly put out under communism in past decades. People are responding to the Gospel and hungry for God's Word and Sacrament. Our prayer is that Rocky Mountain District will make a difference in this seminary reaching financial self-sufficiency as it continues to educate, serve, and minister to the people of Eurasia.
