✝ IN THE LORD'S HOUSE TODAY ✝

OBVIOUSLY, we are not in the Lord's House today due to the COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic, voluntarily taking measures to slow its spread, and the local government stay-at-home orders. Nevertheless, we are making the Service of the Word available on Hope's [Facebook page](#), beginning at 9:00 am on Sunday mornings. Only a pre-selected group of ten people, or less, are allowed to be in the church on Sunday mornings. By advice and encouragement from the Missouri District office, we are no longer offering times for the Service of the Sacrament during this crisis. However, we continue to find comfort, peace, and strength in our Lord's other means of grace—His Word, Baptism, and Absolution.

✝ THE WORD FOR TODAY ✝

JESUS PROMISES TO SEND HIS HOLY SPIRIT, THE HELPER

Though Jesus has departed from us visibly to the right hand of the Father who sent Him, yet this is to our advantage. For Jesus—who is Lord over all creation, who intercedes for us before the Father, who is preparing a place for us in heaven—has sent the Helper, the Spirit of Truth (John 16:5–15). “*Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights*” through Jesus Christ (James 1:17). The Holy Spirit helps us by taking what is Christ’s and declaring it to us. In the Word of truth, the Spirit works repentance and delivers to us the forgiveness of sins, the righteousness of Christ, and victory over the devil. For the ruler of this world is judged and defeated by the cross. Through the ministry of the Holy Spirit, we have been brought forth to new life in Him who is the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. Confident of our resurrection with Christ we confess, “*Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and will not be afraid*” (Is. 12:2).

SING PRAISE TO GOD, THE HIGHEST GOOD (LSB 819)

Today we are substituting the assigned Hymn of the Day for the 5th Sunday of Easter. Due to our service stream, twelve stanzas of *Dear Christians One and All, Rejoice* (LSB 556) felt a little lengthy. I would encourage you to make use of it as a devotion throughout the week. Our substitute Hymn of the Day was written in the 17th century by Johann Jacob Schutz, a German lawyer. It quickly became a treasured part of congregational hymnody. The refrain, “To God all praise and glory!” fits well with the theme of this CANTATE Sunday, encouraging us to “Sing to God a new song.” This name and theme comes from the traditional Introit for this day, “*Cantate Domino canticum novum*” (Sing to the Lord a new song – Psalm 98). What a true joy to use our voices to sing praise to our redeeming Lord!
